  - Do not block any air ventilation grills to keep air flowing!

## Keep your work area dusted! A dusty surface encourages microbial growth. Swiffer dusters work great for this purpose

- Do not keep standing water on or near your workspace, and keep fabrics (i.e. carpet) dry! Moisture promotes microbial growth.




- The Herschler was constructed to allow for spectacular views of the Capitol Building The Herschler was building named Herschler, Governor Ed a Democrat
  - Kemmerer, Wyoming. Herschler was elected in 1974, and re-elected in 1978 and 1982.




